This info pack is for participants booked onto a **Mendip Basecamp** Gold DofE Residential. These usually take place during the May Half Term.


YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES:

Mendip Basecamp is located just a short, 5 minute walk, from Mendip Lodge and Mendip Activity Centre.



ESSENTIAL KIT LIST

- Sleeping bag & pillow
- Wash kit & towel
- Activity clothing all activities require comfy clothing and closed toe shoes that you can
 move around in and that you don't mind getting muddy or wet. Please do not wear jeans
 for activity sessions.
- A complete change of clothes for the watersports day including a pair of old trainers that can get wet
- Waterproof coat and waterproof trousers
- Old Towel (as well as a wash towel)
- Walking boots or wellies
- Refillable water bottle
- Sun block, sun hat & sunglasses
- Cold weather gear (woolly hat & gloves)
- Small rucksack to carry packed lunches to activity sites

RECOMMENDED EXTRAS

- Torch
- Plastic bags to bring wet gear home
- Sun block, sun hat & sunglasses
- Mendip will provide three full meals per day but you are welcome to bring snacks with you
- Please note that Mendip cannot accept responsibility for any valuables that you choose to bring with you
- There is a café onsite at Mendip Activity Centre and refreshments available to purchase.
 Mendip Activity Centre is a cashless venue.



Alcohol

Mendip's Gold DofE residential Lodge is an alcohol free zone. Regardless of age, we cannot allow participants to consume alcohol whilst in our care.

Tents

All bunk tents will be single gender. Unless it has been agreed with parents/guardians before arrival, under 18's will not share a room with anyone aged 18 or over. Socialising is not permitted in bunk tents, only named persons will be allowed to enter their own tent.

Leaving site

Under 18's are not permitted to leave the Mendip site whilst on residential premises, unless a parent or guardian provides a written statement allowing this, prior to your arrival.

Over 18's are permitted to leave but it is asked that they let the residential lead know before leaving.

Medical declaration

Participants aged 16 or over are able to sign their own medical declaration. You are welcome to fill this in when you arrive or <u>click here</u> to print and sign before your arrival.
